**Nominees should:** be active or life members of the APTA Section on Pediatrics and have evidence of at least 5 years professional practice of at least 25 hours/week in clinical settings; of going “above and beyond” typical job expectations including exhibiting creativity, adaptability, energy, dedication, and innovation; of at least one of the following (asset but not requirement): advocacy, volunteer work, community service, or service to underserved populations; of competency as identified by each of the following: experiences of colleagues and clients or caregivers, ability to make intervention meaningful to children and families, effectiveness in meeting identified goals for children; and, for PTAs, of excellence in partnering with supervising PTs.

**Nominators should submit:** this completed form, a letter of nomination, including reasons why the nominee is best suited for this award; a CV of the nominee; and letters of support describing examples of outstanding clinical practice as listed above from: at least one client or caregiver, at least three colleagues, and, for PTAs, at least one supervising PT.
